


VENUE & IMPORTANT INFO

Get familiar early with the BCC's floor plan. Parking is free! No stairs, no elevators--yay! Designer Day workshops will take place within the Connect C and Collaborate series of rooms. The onsite scrapbook store is open to the public. It will be located in Collaborate C; Store opens to public Friday! More info coming soon!



DESIGNER DAY REGISTRATION

After paying for workshops online & securing your classes, if attending in person, registration a the BCC begins promptly at 7am. Doors will open to workshop rooms at 7:30am Please register at the time of your workshop not before. If you paid for more than one workshop you can register all at the same time.

HOW DO I MAKE THE MOST OF DESIGNER DAY?

We strongly recommend getting acquainted with the supply list, map and schedule. Print and reading it will help you feel super prepared by the time you arrive. Get supplies organized for each workshop, especially your photos to maximize your workshop potential! Best of all, get a lot of rest before vou arrive.

PAST ATTENDEES HELPFUL TIPS:

GET LOTS OF SLEEP PRIOR to arriving, this newsletter is your best friend! Most importantly have fun and don't stress!

- 1. Definitely bring lots of adhesive, I ran out the first year.
- 2. Pack clothes you can layer-sometimes the rooms are chilly.
- 3. Some small things: Paper clips & Ziploc bags for smaller bits & pieces of ephemera leftover, white cardstock if you want to make placeholders for photos. Post-Its are great for adding notes to your projects (special instructions, something you might want to add that you have at home, etc.)
- 4. I have found that lunch time can be tricky plan ahead if you are taking classes all day.
- 5. Bring wet wipe packages. Can never have enough.
- 6. I learned to only bring what's on the supply lists.
- 7. I use a few pouches and categorize similar items. I also break out my Designer Day class needs it helped a lot!

A FEW THINGS TO KNOW:

- 1. There are multiple workshops going on at one time. Be sure to not over-book yourself!
- 2. Tickets will be required for workshop entry.

WHAT IS DESIGNER DAY? This super fun "bonus" event is separate from She Loves Color; Designer Day is a pre-event offering unique educators and workshops different from the main She Loves Color event! Workshops are sold ala carte online with your option to purchase a seat in class (ATTENDING), or have a kit shipped to you after the event takes place (SHIP TO ME).

WHEN? Sunday, June 29th, 2025.

WHERE? Workshops and No Frills All Day Crop will be hosted at the same venue as She Loves Color: The Brookfield Conference Center at 325 S. Moorland Road, Brookfield, WI 53005

HOW DO I SIGN UP? Visit BellaBlvd.net's private link and password to access the Designer Day offering. Choose ATTENDING if you'd like to attend in person. Choose SHIP TO ME if you'd like the workshop kit shipped to you (after the event in October). Registration will close July 3rd.

Please note if you are not seeing the workshop you want, it is sold out and unavailable. Only viewable workshops are available for purchase.

HOW MUCH WILL THESE WORKSHOPS COST AND HOW DO I PAY? Workshops prices are consistent: albums \$55, layouts \$45, cards \$35. All workshops must be paid in full during sign-up via bellablvd.net.

IS THERE A CANCELLATION POLICY? All sales are final, as teachers plan for kit quantities and product purchasing. Your payment will be forfeited as a result of cancellation. **No refunds will be issued.**

WHAT IS THE DESIGNER DAY SCHEDULE LIKE? Workshops will start at 8am and finish at 4:30pm. Classes are two hours long, except Stephanie Smokovich's lunch break workshop-see class times.

Supplies List: Paper trimmer, tape runner/tear tape, foam (variety of sizes), liquid adhesive, scissors, pencil, border punches - 2 designs I recommend scallop & doily, 3/16" hole punch, 1"& 1.5" circle punches. Optional: T-ruler, xacto knife & self healing mat.

BASIC LAYOUT WORKSHOP: Christmas Cheer 10:30am-12:30pm

In this joyful workshop, we'll create 4 festive 12" pages (incl. a doublepage spread) capturing the magic of the season. Learn how to layer patterns, mix embellies, & add interactive touches. Supplies List: Paper trimmer, tape runner/tear tape, foam, liquid adhesive, scissors, pencil, wax tip tool to work with sequins. Optional: T-ruler, distressing tool, small sanding square/tool.

Supply List: Craft Mat, 12" paper trimmer, scissors, pencil, black pen for outlining, ruler, favorite wet adhesive (thin tip glue works best), favorite dry adhesive, 1/4" score-tape/strong double-sided adhesive, foam tape (regular & thin strip sizes), foam, scoring tool & board, bone folder, 1/8" hole punch. Optional: Diamond Stickles (for glitter effect), tray to sort die cuts.

INTERMEDIATE LAYOUT WORKSHOP: Mom & Dad

Supply List: 12" trimmer, scissors, favorite everyday adhesive, liquid glue, foam adhesive, tiny attacher/stapler, 1/4" hole punch, any border punch (I used a small scallop), Tsquare, fine tip black pen, ruler.

Optional: Photos of mom - (1) 4.25x5.5" vertical. Photos of dad - (1) 3x3", (1) 3x5" vertical. Second dad page - (1) 4x6" vertical.

INTERMEDIATE LAYOUT WORKSHOP: **Bow Wow**

**Note this workshop will not be taught in person; Pick-Up or Ship To Me Kits Only! **

Love is certainly a four legged word! From puppy love to spoiled dog create three 12" pages with Bella Blvd's newest Bow Wow collection. Play with circles and triangles, patterns galore along with some pawfectly worded ephemera elements. Try your hand at doodling as you document the family dog-or dogs-, whether he or she, with these pawsome pages including dimensional pops, puffy stickers and lots of layers!

Supply List: 12" trimmer, scissors, favorite everyday adhesive, liquid glue, foam adhesive (tape & squares), tiny attacher/stapler, any border punch (I used a small scallop),black gel pen, xacto knife & straight edge, self healing mat, 2" circle punch.

Optional: Photos for page one: (1)4x4". Page two: (3) 2.5x3.5" vertical.

Page three: (2) 3x4.5" vertical or (1) 6.25x4.5" horizontal.
