

To All Our Prayer Warriors:

I am not alone praying almost 7 years for healing prayer because you've been with us. I am overwhelmed by you and how God has put you in our lives as I asked for prayer for my sister, Lee, since her cancer surgery in 2015.

We all thought the pain would gradually subside after the surgery, but each year brought increasing intractable pain, uncontrollable by opioids, medical marijuana and pain management of all types.

Lee's life has been failed medical procedures, muscle wasting, skin ulcerations, and osteoporosis due to malnutrition. We searched for years for something to control the pain she lived with each day.

Lee asked God for help. She became discouraged, bitter, and angry. You, my friends, stood in the gap with your love, prayers and concern for years. She has always been amazed, with all these people that don't know her pray and ask about her.

Lee's Miracle:

Lee spoke to me on the phone today. She was sobbing, but this time it was not due to the intractable pain. Her cries were that of joy that God has healed her. She shared with me that about a month ago she began to pray The Our Father, The Lord's Prayer, several times a day while she was in agony.

She prayed and asked God to forgive her for her anger and unbelief and that she knows that He loves her very much and that He is going to heal her. Lee was given the insight that her sickness was not punishment, nor was it given to her by God. Lee had read the book *When Bad Things Happen to Good People*, by Rabbi Harold Kushner.

Now, a month of her prayers had passed and the intractable pain continued. Lee persisted in telling God that she knows He loves her very much and He will heal her. Lee told me that it was March 17th, St. Patrick's Day, when she woke with no pain and she did not have pain that day, nor the next day. And now the third day, as she spoke to me and told me through joyful cries and exclamations of gratitude that Jesus has given her a miracle of healing. There is no other explanation after seven years.

Lee was hunched over for many years and now stands upright as she was speaking to me. She had skin grafts last week that are totally healed. She is cancer free, pain free, and is thankful and praising the Greatest Physician for her healing.

Lee told me that what kept her from suicidal thoughts was knowing how many people loved her and were praying for her. Those people are you, my beloved friends, family and prayer warriors. Each time I spoke to her she was in disbelief of how many people were caring for her and she said the love kept her going to persist and hang on longer until she received her miracle. Lee would always say to please thank all of these people, so I send this to you.

Your love, friendship, and prayers will never be forgotten.

May I ask that you share this, continue with prayers of thanksgiving for Lee's miracle and for others suffering. People need to know that they are loved by someone, not forgotten, and that nothing is hopeless. God's will and the power of prayer really can save someone's life.
