- 5. Can you describe how it works without jargon?
- 6. Do you have any idea how it might be manufactured?

- 8. Do you have a budget range in mind?
- 9. Do you know what skills you have-and what you need help with?
- 10. Can you name 1 or 2 next steps you'd take after this?

Scoring:

0-3 points: Slow down. Your idea needs development before prototyping.

4-7 points: Promising! But you may need technical or business guidance.

8-10 points: Strong concept. It may be time to start documenting and validating.
