



PERSONALISED TAROT READING FOR

A. CLIENT

Dear client,

Thank you so much for requesting a Tarot reading with me.

To tune into your energy today, I cleared my sacred space with incense and spent some time in meditation to clear my mind. I invoked my personal spiritual guides and asked for my own higher self to be able to connect and receive messages to be reflected in the reading.

To be open to receiving the messages of this reading, I encourage you to close your eyes, breathe deeply and clear your mind. Tune in to your question or situation, and set the intention to receive the guidance you need right now.

To review, you asked me “I’d like a general reading about what’s going to happen over the next few months. Particularly in the areas of the new business I’m launching and any relationships.”

You are searching for guidance from the Tarot that will help you get closer to that discovery.

Based on your question, I chose the Radiant Waite Tarot deck (borderless from Lo Scarebo), one of my favourite decks. It has a stronger more “masculine” energy than some of the other Rider-Waite variants! I used a twelve-card spread I will explain as I go through the cards.

After taking a moment to centre myself, I used my pendulum to ensure that I had a clear connection to my own higher self and through that to your higher self, asking that I receive information in the highest and best way for you. I pulled the following cards for you:



The first row of the spread is month 1, the second-row month 2 and the third-row month 3. The first column is home, the second column business/work, the third column love/relationship and the final fourth column is finances.

Here is your reading...

Home Life

Month 1 (March): Four of Cups

Then Four of Cups can appear when you are feeling bored or even disappointed in someone or something. You can see that the man in the card is being offered a cup which he is currently choosing to ignore, or that he is holding off from deciding. This card suggests that in March you have some issues around your present living accommodation you may have to deal with.

Are you dissatisfied with where you are living right now, or have you been offered another place to live, and you are considering whether to accept? Either way, this card suggests that an offer has, or will be made to you in some form around your home (such as a new place to live or changes that you have the opportunity to make to your current living accommodation – although it feels more like the former than the latter) and you hold off trying to decide what to do because you want more time for consideration and reflection.

Month 2 (April): Five of Cups (reversed)

The cards were well shuffled so it's interesting to get two consecutive cards next to each other, albeit one reversed. The Five of Cups reversed in its upright form indicates loss, regret, and disappointment. However here in this reading it appears reversed, suggesting that you are starting to recover from the loss and disappointment of your marriage, and you are now accepting the past and starting to move on. So, this is a positive message even though the card might not look quite so positive!

There are many situations represented by this card. It suggests that you are starting to learn to be more open to opportunities and you are learning to take risks again. The feeling I get is that after leaving a long marriage there is a period of adjustment where you must get used to making decisions for yourself and not having to always consider your partner. This card suggests you are starting to adjust to that new situation now and you are learning to operate with more freedom than you had in your marriage. In fact, this card reversed can also suggest a beginning of new loves and new relationships, something that is highlighted by the Two of Cups appearing for the month of March in your love/relationships column (see below).

Finally, the Five of Cups reversed is about values and starting to understand what you truly want and what will make you happiest. It seems that in April you start to have many realisations and insights about what you want, you start to accept and move on from the past, and you start to become much more open to new relationships – not necessarily for long-term commitment but more for fun.

Month 3 (May): The Queen of Swords

Finally for the month of May we have the Queen of Swords (the “superwoman” of the Tarot Deck!). The Queen of Swords is a quick thinker, organised and perceptive but she is also devoid of emotion! She indicates independence of thought and judgement.

She is also brutally honest and tells it like it is. In this position representing your home, she suggests that after the soul-searching and re-evaluation of your values, wants and needs in April, in May you become very clear on what you want, you understand what is important to you and you become very focussed on ensuring that your values are met. There is a renewed focus and determination to your life, and this shows up too in the corresponding work column where you have the Eight of Pentacles indicating focussed hard work leading towards a very specific and definite outcome.

Work/Career

In the next three months on the work front, things move quickly, you have great energy and enthusiasm, and you are working very hard. This creates some positive energy and outcomes. I get the feeling from the cards that your new business venture is an opportunity for you to “throw yourself” into a new project after a challenging time (“The Chariot”), and this gives you something positive to focus on and will create a positive outcome for you.

Month 1 (March): The Knight of Swords

The Knight of Swords represents action, being obsessed with an idea and going “all out” to achieve that idea almost to the exclusion of all else. He can be hasty and go “where angels fear to tread!”

In this position he represents work/career, and he indicates that with the new business you are launching, you are actively pursuing your goals and pushing your projects and tasks forward with energy and enthusiasm. It indicates that there could be some battles and challenging situations along the way, but you are well equipped to deal with these, and you come out on top because you have solid arguments, and you can articulate these arguments well (Swords are about words, thoughts, and beliefs).

Month 2 (April): The Chariot

The Chariot represents a fast-moving energy, conquest, victory, will power and determination. This again shows you charging forward in April with your work, fiercely determined, taking more control and more responsibility in a leadership role of some kind. You are firm in what you believe and stand for as far as your business venture is concerned. You have strong self-discipline and will not be knocked off track. The Chariot indicates that hard work and determination will pay off and you will successfully achieve the goals you set for yourself.

Month 3 (May): The Eight of Pentacles

In May you continue the hard work that you put in in April. Then Eight of Pentacles can also suggest that in addition to just straight hard focussed work, you are learning many new things and maybe even you are attending training courses in relation to your work. This card also suggests that by May you know that you are in the right place, that you have made the right decision regarding your business and that things are moving along apace.

Love/Relationships

Month 1 (March): The Two of Cups

What a card to get in the love/relationships column! Typically, this card suggests that the partner you have been waiting for appears and a new relationship will blossom! This will be someone with whom you connect at a very deep level and there is a strong mutual attraction. The Two of Cups does not necessarily indicate that this relationship will stand the test of time, but it does indicate the strength of the connection between you and it indicates the potential for a long lasting relationship if that is what you both want.

Month 2 (April): The Wheel of Fortune

In May you have the Wheel of Fortune, another interesting card to get in the column of relationships! This suggests to me that the person you may well meet this month (indicated by the Two of Cups) is someone with whom you have a karmic connection from a past life, and you come together to work out that karma. The relationship could go either way – in other words you could work out the karma between you and decide that whatever was between you is now completed, or that you complete your karma and that clears the way for a deeper and more meaningful relationship. This isn't clear from the Wheel of Fortune – it says it could go either way.

Month 3 (May): The King of Cups

However, the King of Cups clarifies the picture depicted by the Wheel of Fortune. The king of Cups is emotionally balanced, sensitive, and compassionate. He represents an ideal partner (male or female). So this suggests that in May the person who comes into your life this month probably is there for the longer term, rather than a quick “fling” of a month or so. Even if this turns out not to be the case, it suggests that your love/relationship experience over the next three months will be fun, passionate and a bit of a roller coaster!

Finance

Month 1 (March): The Moon

This month you have The Moon, a card illusion, fear, anxiety. In this position it suggests that your financial picture is not totally clear yet following your separation from your wife, and the advice of the Moon is not to make any major financial decisions this month. There could also be financial issues going on that you are not yet aware of so this is a time to be conservative and careful.

Month 2 (April): Judgement (Reversed)

However, in April, be careful that the doubt and wariness of March doesn't turn into paranoia in April! Your carefulness in March pays off in April and some things start to become clearer and you can start to move things forward financially in April.

Judgement reversed reminds us that we do have control over every decision that we make, and for us to not be overly hard on ourselves if we do make choices that don't work out, but to learn from our mistakes.

Month 3 (May): The King of Swords

The King of Swords represents intellectual power and authority. He has the courage and the intellect to achieve his goals. Here this suggests that this is indeed so and your new business going well adds to the general feeling of financial wellbeing in May. Indeed, if you look across the bottom row of the spread, you have all positive cards looking towards the King of Swords, suggesting positive energy is flowing towards your increasing financial success in May.

Summary

I would say this is a positive and upbeat reading for the next three months.

These times will not be without their ups and downs (the Wheel of Fortune) but these are only bumps along the road to a great success. There will be a period of coming to terms and accepting the past (Five of Cups reversed) and out of that introspection and healing will come a renewed energy and enthusiasm for the opportunities that present themselves to you.
