

# HOMEMADE PINECONE BIRD FEEDER

**Step 1:** Clean the pine cone – shake/brush off any debris. If the scales are tight, consider removing some to make more room for seed.

**Step 2:** Tie the string/twine approximately ½" from the top of the cone at its centre. Make sure the string is tied tightly!

**Step 3:** Coat the cone with a layer of peanut butter, as thick or thin as desired, pressing peanut butter between the scales and filling in large gaps.

**Step 4:** Roll the cone in birdseed using a shallow dish - press lightly to keep the seed adhered to the cone and gently work the seed in.

**Step 5:** Find a nice spot to hang your Migration Munchie – we suggest a place where you can watch the birds enjoying their yummy welcome back treat!
