There is a common misconception, one that lurks in the shadows, whispering lies: that adventure is dangerous, while routine is safe. Bosh. There is a truth far bolder: **routine, not adventure, is the silent assassin, the thief of aliveness.**

Of course, scaling an unclimbed peak or rafting uncharted waters carries inherent risks. But after the scrapes and triumphs, it becomes evident that true danger often hides in plain sight. The slow erosion of the spirit, the gradual numbing of the senses, the comfortable cage built around us – that is the real threat. It's the insidious routine that saps curiosity, leaving a hollow shell, sleepwalking through predictable days.

The peril lies not in facing the unknown, but in succumbing to the numbing embrace of the familiar. Routine is the silent killer of the human spirit – a slow, insidious force that saps vitality, dulls the senses, and robs the opportunity to truly experience life in all its richness and complexity.

Remember our younger selves, eyes wide with wonder, chasing fireflies and building forts? Every turn revealed something fresh and new. Where did that spark go? **Drowned in a sea of "coulda, woulda, shoulda." Adventure rekindles that flame. It's the unexpected detour, the spontaneous interaction with a stranger, the "yes" uttered instead of the usual "no."** It's the jolt that reminds us of being alive, not simply existing.

I'm not advocating recklessness or heedless pursuits of trouble. Calculated risks, sure, but not blind leaps. Adventure thrives on preparation, on honing skills and expanding knowledge. It's the thrill of pushing limits, not exceeding them. Even Everest starts with a first step.

Oh, and the rewards, the riches to be plundered! **Not gold or portfolios or acquired things, but experiences that weave the tapestry of life.** The laughter shared around a campfire with newfound friends, the vista that takes the breath away, the quiet moment of connection with nature's symphony. These are honest treasures, far more valuable than any material possession.

While the trail to adventure may be fraught with challenges, uncertainties, even blood, it is also a path that leads to growth, discovery, transformation and, ultimately, a deeper understanding of ourselves and the world around us. It is a call to embrace a mindset of openness and resilience in the face of life's trials. Only by reaching high can we climb the heights of our capabilities and unlock the potential of our humanity.

So, I urge, step outside the comfort zone; step outside. Don't let the fear of the unknown paralyze. The greatest risk is not taking one at all. Embrace adventure, in whatever form it takes. Hike a new trail, color in the map, strike up a conversation with that interesting person in the corner, learn a new skill. Let curiosity be the compass, courage the fuel, and live a life that resonates with the vibrant hum of enchantment and brio.

The only true danger is living a life devoid of the blaze that fires us with wonder. The world awaits, teeming with the sublime, the magical and the many wild mysteries to be unpuzzled. In the end, it is not the hazards of adventure that we should fear, but the lethality of a life lived without it

Decades ago, I made the first raft descent of the lower Alsek, and now Laura and I have chartered a July 6th departure for a custom 8-day eyepopping adventure.

"The Most Visually Stunning Corridor In the World"

I wrote that when rafting the lower Alsek River in Aslaka, a stretch as pure a wilderness as can be found.

And the description holds true today.

It usually takes 13-days to traverse the Alsek, but Laura and I have put together a special 8-day charter that uses helicopters to transport around the less scenic upper section and the notorious Turn Back Canyon, optimizing the time to experience the most awesome elements of a pageant-filled trip.

As we journey down the Alsek River, we'll ride through the largest contiguous protected wilderness in the world - including Kluane National Park & Reserve in the Yukon and Glacier Bay National Park in Alaska. Purl past a galaxy of glaciers, by the largest concentration of grizzlies, and beneath the greatest wheels of bald eagles in the world.

Here I am below with our son, Jasper, and Laura on his left.






Raft past stunning glaciers and keep an eye out for spectacular wildlife, from grizzlies to marmots and moose. Camp riverside and enjoy delicious meals while listening to river lore around the campfire.




