

**Stephen T. Higgins, PhD**, is the Director of the Vermont Center on Behavior and Health and has been Principal Investigator on multiple NIH grants covering the concepts and methods of behavioral economics and behavioral pharmacology to investigate tobacco, illicit drugs, and other health-related risk behaviors in vulnerable populations. This research has also been supported by an NIGMS Center for Biomedical Research Excellence (COBRE) award and a NIDA/FDA Tobacco Centers of Regulatory Science award. Dr. Higgins has also been the Principal Investigator on a 35+ year NIDA Institutional Training award.

He is a University Distinguished Professor and the Virginia H. Donaldson Endowed Professor of Translational Science in the Departments of Psychiatry and Psychological Science. Dr. Higgins has held many national scientific leadership positions, including terms as President of the College on Problems of Drug Dependence and the American Psychological Association's Division on Psychopharmacology and Substance Abuse. He is the author of more than 475 journal articles and invited book chapters and editor of a dozen volumes and therapist manuals in the area of behavior and health.
