Amenities will include a beach club, wellness center, athletic club, pool deck with dining, bar and lounge, the Ellipse Club, with a cognac room, lounge, billiards tables and a wine vault and bar and a Residents Club with bar and lounge. Groundbreaking is planned for mid-2023, with completion expected in mid-2026. Prices start at \$4.5 million.
