Some data for you: 183 weekends in 40 years—80 Men's and 101 Women's plus 2 combined weekends in 2023 and 2025. 3872 Parishioners participated as candidates then served on teams. 1988 had a record 12 weekends, followed by 1989 with 11. There were 4 servant communities in past years and Secretariat had up to 19 members and Servant community operated in 4 regions, Brisbane, Western, Northern and Gold Coast.
