Keeping Our Community Safe

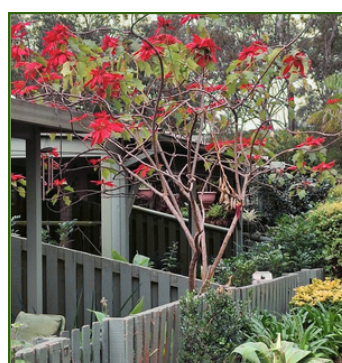

Winter Has Arrived!

Winter Gardening: Get Involved!

- **Winter Veggie Patch:** Now is the ideal window to plant winter crops like garlic, onions, spinach, and kale.
- **Colorful Beds:** If you have personal pots or garden edges, think about planting some winter-hardy annuals like pansies, violas, or cyclamens to add a bright pop of color against the gray winter mornings.
- **Pruning Time:** It's a great month to cut back your rose bushes and deciduous shrubs to give them maximum strength for a spectacular spring bloom.
