Dating questions that can be used on a first date.

These questions help to create more connection and fun, and reveal some core beliefs and qualities of the person across the table.

Some tips to remember:

- Make it fun and interesting when asking these questions
- Respect the answers they give
- Don't use these questions at the beginning. Make each other comfortable first
- ❖ Be 100 percent honest in your answers
- ❖ Never answer a question with another question
- ❖ Introduce the questions by asking if you can both engage in a fun Q&A experience. You can explain that it involves asking a few direct and random questions

8 General Questions

- 1 What TV program would you refuse to give up for a date with me
- 2 If you were thrown in jail for a bad habit, what would it be?
- 3 if you could change anything about the way you were raised what would it be?
- 4 When something cool happen in a movie, are you one of those who clap or smile, or smile understandingly at the clappers?
- 5 What would constitute a perfect date for you?
- 6 is there something you dreamt of doing for a long time? Why haven't you done it?
- 7 Before making a telephone call do you ever rehearse what you're going to say and why?
- 8 When did you last sing to yourself or someone else?

(Exploring Christian values)

- 1. Do they have the same beliefs as you? (Are they a Christian?)
- 2. "What is something that you don't want me to know about you?"
- 3. "What is something you do want me to know about you?"
- 4. Ask about their family and what kind of relationship they have with their family members.
- 5. "Describe yourself in three words."
- 6. "What has been your greatest failure?"
- 7. "What has been your greatest achievement?"
- 8. "Walk me through a day in your life."
- 9. "If you had to think happy thoughts in order to fly, what would you think about?"
- 10. (If they are a Christian): "Would you describe your relationship with Jesus cold, lukewarm, or hot, and why?"
- 11. "If you could go back and do something in your life differently, what would it be?"
- 12. "What do you look for in a significant other?"
- 13. (Possible follow-up to question twelve if you want to): "Do you match that description?"
- 14. "What is something that has made you laugh until you cried?"
- 15. "Why did your previous relationships not work out?"
